Having flown the coop to enjoy the hospitality of the Young Farmers gathering in Blackpool, our regular Birdman missed out on a cracking morning's auctioneering, with trade as sizzling as the weather!

With close to all available pens bulging with a massive variety of Poultry, Waterfowl, Rabbits, Guinea Pigs etc (and the odd Ferret), there was only just room for the massive crowd that gathered, in our traditional Bank Holiday Monday style!

Prices reflected the massive demand, with some breeders and vendors returning home with proceeds at least 3 times their wildest dreams!

Not surprisingly after the wet Winter, all Ducks were in vogue! Top price of **£46 per head** was achieved for a pen of 4 **dark grey Call Ducks** from Miss H Jones, with other Call Ducks to £28, Aylesbury Ducks made up to £24, and Black East Indian Ducks sold to £22.

Hens were 'flying' again, a trio of **POL Gold Silkies** from I F Lloyd roaring past last week's best **at £36** per head. Up £10 on the week!! A lovely trio of Golden Pheasants caused some excitement, eventually sold £22 per head, with another trio to £20. A beautiful pen of SilverLaced Wyandotte Bantams made £20, with a pair of Shamo's also to £20, and, amongst the other POL hens, Buff Orpingtons sold for £20, Marans made to £18, Partridge Silkies to £18, Light Sussex to £17, Cuckoo Silkies to £16 etc, etc. Goslings sold to £14, and several runs of unsexed hatched Ducklings sold between £3 and £4.50.

Amongst the larger, ornamental fowl, Peahens made to £44, a breeding pair of Peacocks £40 each, Shapho game made up to £42, and a trio of POL Colombian Brahma's made £36 each.

A Hencote and stand made £60, and incubators sold to £34. A lot of Eggs met limited demand except for anything out of the ordinary, with several lots of Silkies to £9/doz, Red Golden Pheasant to £7/doz etc etc.

Basic Payment Scheme 2018

It's the time of year again in which BPS claims need to be completed, please find below a summary of this year's updates :-

The RPA have undertaken proactive land change detection (PLCD) mapping updates which can lead to incorrect land data. Therefore it is extremely important to check your online maps and query and incorrect updates, these can include land cover changed, temporary electric fences mapped as permanent boundaries etc

Is your land currently, or sometime during the year going to be affected by transport or utility works? If such works last for over 28 days you must withdraw the land from your BPS application to prevent a penalty, compensation for the loss of BPS payment can be claimed for.

Transferring land to a new owner or tenant can be completed online, if an error occurs during this process you must complete a paper RLE1 form to transfer/remove the affected parcel.

We have now began the process of transferring entitlements, we expect further entitlements to come onto the market in the coming weeks therefore ensure that you have the current number of entitlements to match the eligible hectares in which you are claiming on. If they are not used, you will lose them!

New greening rules, with key changes including 'trees in a line' under the EFA hedges option, the inclusion of field margins under the EFA buffer strip option and EFA fallow cover now converts to permanent grassland and the management rules have now changed.

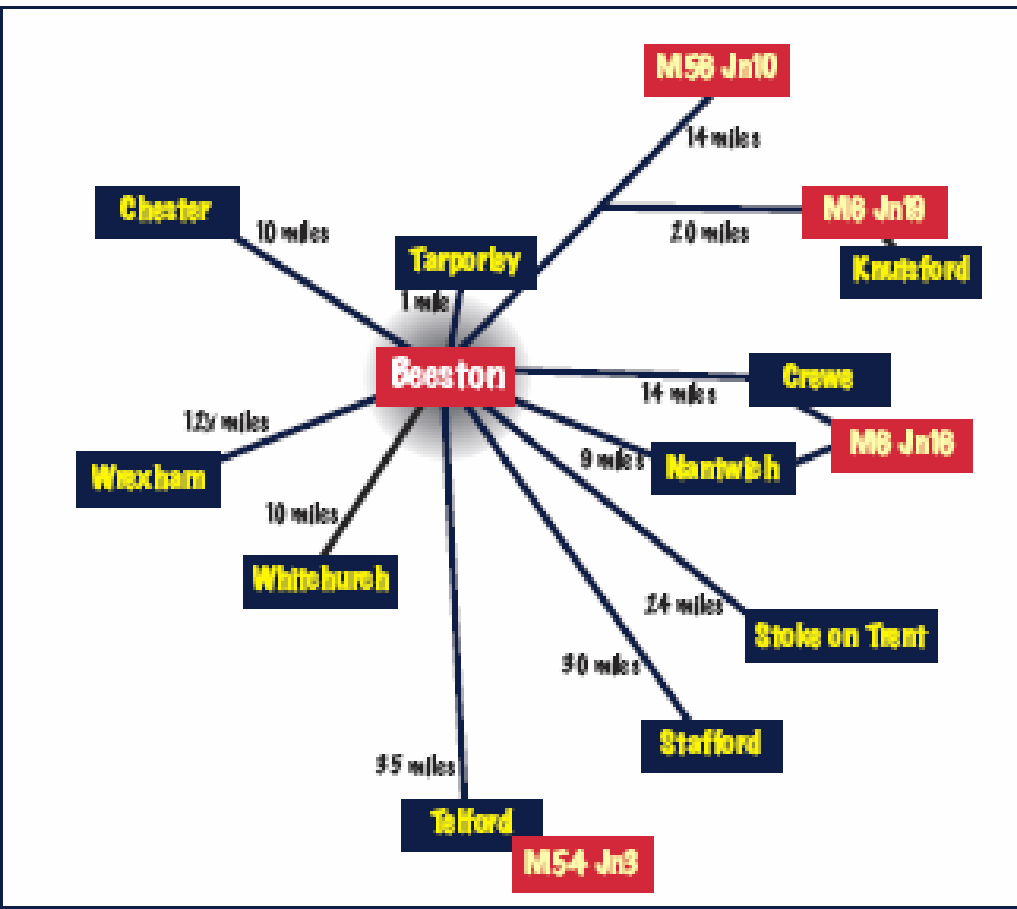
