Best pork weights from North Wales topped the trade at 152p/kg (£106.40), Boar pigs from the same good home to 140p/kg or £101.08 in the lump.

Top pen of cutter weights to 133p/kg or £125.02 from Richard Wilson but the majority of today's entry made up of Bacon weights, peaking at 120p/kg but ALL grossing over £100 to a top of £128.40 for a Peak District finisher.

CHESHIRE HERD DISPERSAL SELLS TO £1900

The dispersal of the entire commercial herd of Holstein Friesian dairy cattle took place at Beeston Castle Auction on behalf of PM & SM Tushingham, Laurel Bank Farm, Clotton, Cheshire on Tuesday, 26th June. This was a good herd of cows, that weren't pushed at all, with plenty of potential for further increase in yields. The sale comprised some 170 head, all of which were in the milking portion.

The sale was well supported from milk producers both locally and from surrounding counties with over thirty individual purchasers from North down to Mid Wales, Anglesey, Shropshire, Staffordshire as well as Cheshire.

Trade for the milkers followed recent trends with anything displaying power and strength, on a sound set of legs and feet, whether they be fresh or back in calf sold readily, and anything lacking condition or calved some time harder to place, with a total of 48 not in-calf having calved in 2017, or displaying cell counts above 400.

Top price was £1900 for a fresh June calved third calver, sired by an unregistered Lovat Brandysnap son and sold giving 32kg, purchased by an undisclosed buyer. Next at £1680 was a Cricket daughter who had calved a week and sold fresh, purchased by a well-known Cheshire buyer. £1660 was paid by the same purchaser, this time for a fresh heifer by Kodak. £1640 was paid by S Ford for a springing heifer by Cricket, carrying a service to Angus.

30th June 2018 – End of crop diversification “cropping” period and end of Ecological Focus Area (EFA) fallow period (Basic Payment Scheme) 2018.

1st August 2018 – If you have been granted a derogation by The Rural Payments Agency, you may be able to cut or trim hedges throughout August and to sow Oilseed Rape or Temporary Grassland.

1st August 2018 – start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high, readily available nitrogen content (for example, slurry, poultry manures, or liquid digested sewage sludge) to tillage land on shallow or sandy soils except where crops will be sown on or before 15th September.

20th August 2018 – E.F.A. catch crops must be established by this date (and retained until at least 14th October).

1st September 2018 – You can cut or trim hedges and trees from this date.

1st September 2018 – Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high, readily available nitrogen content (for example, slurry, poultry manures or liquid digested sewage sludge) to grassland on shallow or sandy soils.

1st September 2018 – Start of closed period for applying manufactured nitrogen fertilisers to tillage land

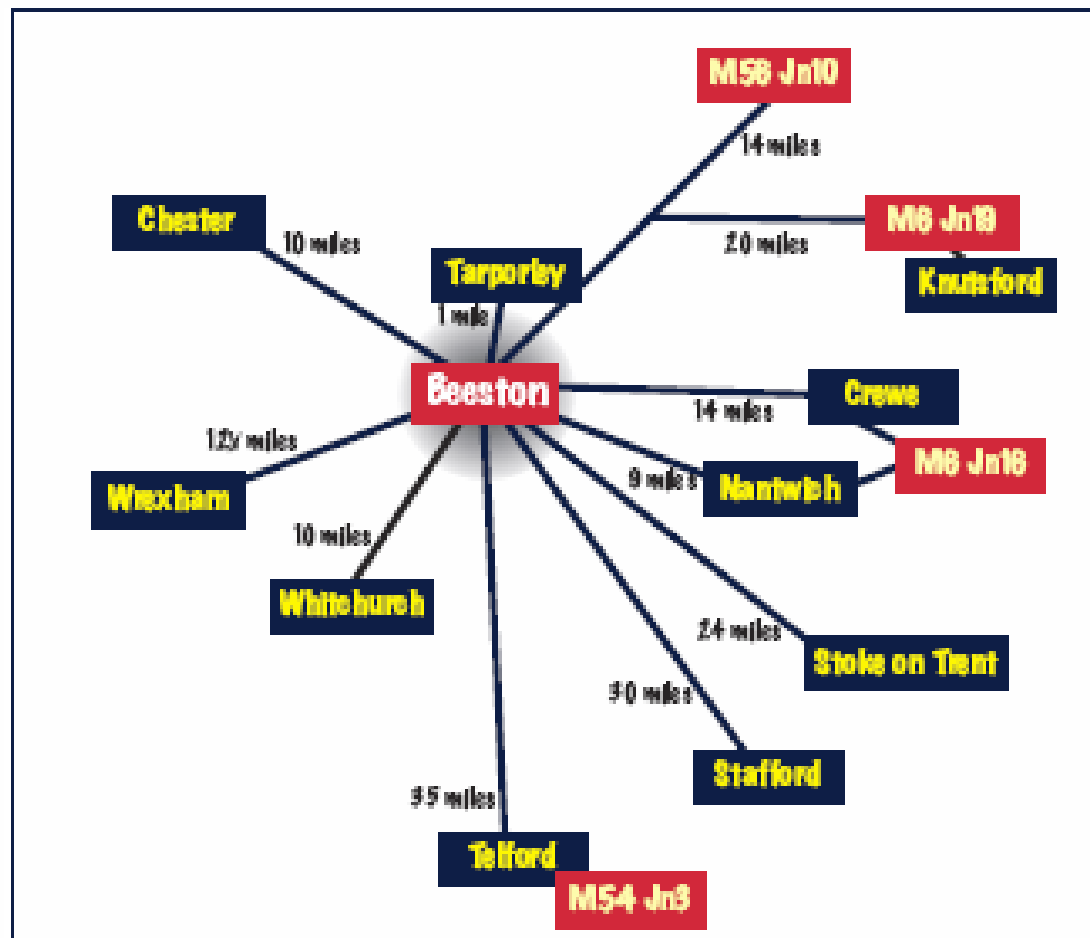
