**BCMS CHANGES TO PASSPORTS**

When you apply for a Passport, you should receive it within 14 days. If you don't, the Passport will be treated as lost and you should contact BCMS.

If BCMS have issued the Passport and you have not received it, they will carry out checks and may send you a replacement free of charge if you have informed them within six weeks.

From 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018, if you do not inform BCMS within six weeks of the date the Passport was produced, you will have to pay a fee of £20 per animal when you apply for the replacement passport. You should also tell BCMS if you have sent in a Passport for any reason and you have not received it back within 14 days.

## Basic Payment Scheme – 2018 – Key Dates - July 2018

**1<sup>st</sup> October:** EFA cover crops must be established by this date (and retained until at least 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019).

**14<sup>th</sup> October:** EFA Catch Crops must be retained until at least this date.

**15<sup>th</sup> October:** Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high readily available nitrogen content (for example, slurry, poultry manures or liquid digested sewage sludge) to Grassland on soils which are not shallow or sandy.

**31<sup>st</sup> October:** If you hold a summer water abstraction licence (authorising abstraction wholly within the months of April to October), The Environment Agency will make actual abstraction return forms available to you from 31<sup>st</sup> October. You then have 28 days to send your readings to the Environment Agency.

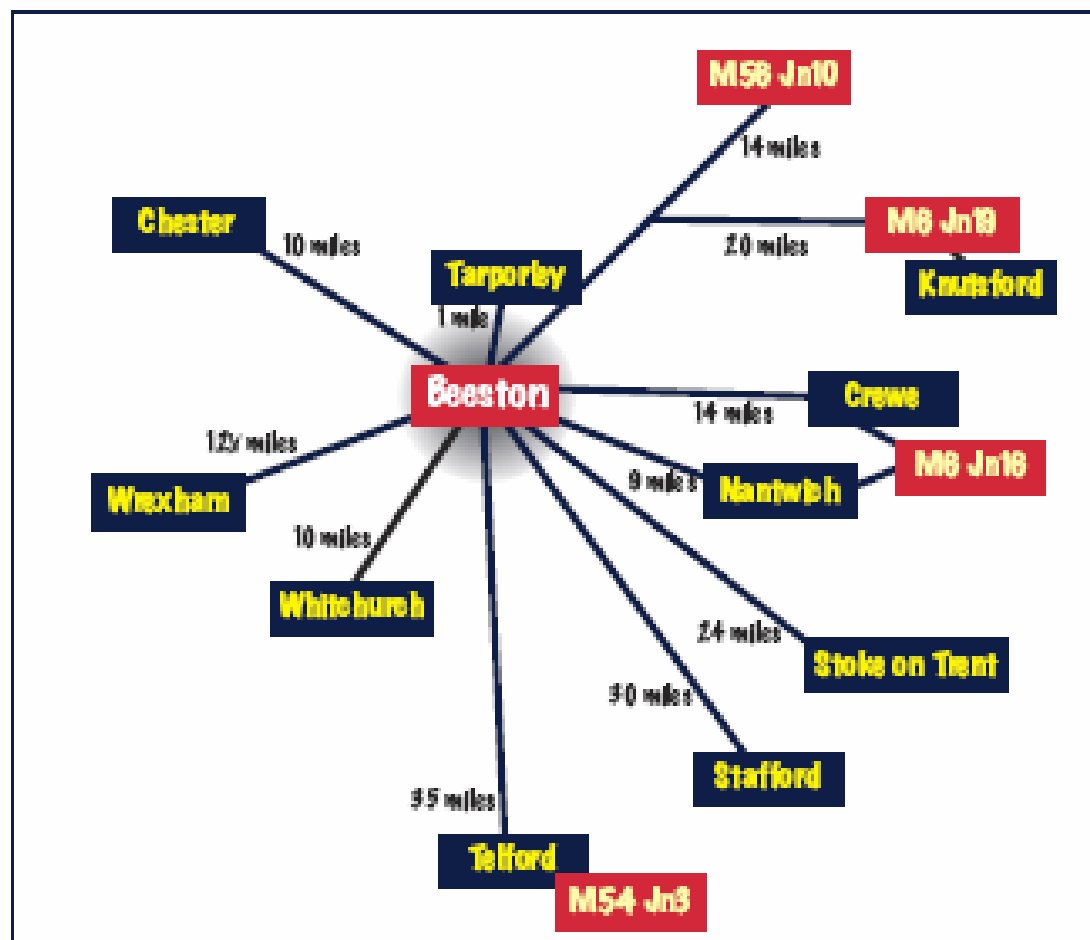
